

Participants for EEG – Study on Decision Making „TONIC EEG“

We are looking for participants in an EEG experiment which involves performing a task on the computer. During the task, your „brain waves“ will be recorded via electrodes placed on your scalp (EEG). EEG records your brain activity while performing a task and gives us the opportunity to study neural mechanisms of cognition.

The experiment will take place on two consecutive days and takes approximately **1.5 – 2 hours**. In total, you will receive a monetary compensation of **24,00 €** or **4 participant hours** (Psych. Students). Additionally you can earn a **BONUS of up to 8,00 €**.

Prerequisites:

- 18 - 40 years of age
- Very good German or English language skills
- good general health condition

Exclusion Criteria:

- symptoms of a cold or flu (fever/temperature, cough, running nose, throat ache, muscle/joint pain, lack of taste/odor sensation, headache, nausea, diarrhea, loss of appetite/weight, conjunctivitis, rash, apathy)
- neurological (e.g. stroke, epilepsy, traumatic brain injury) or
- psychiatric (e.g. depression, anxiety, obsessive-compulsive disorder) diagnoses
- alcohol- or drug abuse
- skin disorders
- dreadlocks

The experiment will take place in building 23 at the main campus of the Otto-von-Guericke University.

To ensure safety for our colleagues and participants we have to adopt special measures. The contact in the laboratory will be minimized. There are medical hygiene products available and we developed a tracing protocol. Under these conditions we can ensure a safe work environment and continue to run experiments.
